Mr. HAYDEN, from the Committee on Appropriations, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H.J. Res. 508]

The Committee on Appropriations, to whom was referred House Joint Resolution 508, making continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 1964, and for other purposes, report the same to the Senate without amendment and with the recommendation that the joint resolution be passed.

This joint resolution provides for appropriations for the continuing of the operation of those functions of the Federal Government for which appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964, have not been enacted. The appropriations made in this joint resolution remain available until August 31, 1963.

In those instances where bills have passed both bodies of the Congress and the amounts or authority therein differ, the pertinent project or activity shall be continued under the lesser of the two amounts approved and under the more restrictive authority.

Where a bill has passed only one House, or where an appropriation for a project or activity is included in only one version of the bill as passed by both Houses, the pertinent project or activity shall be continued under the appropriation, fund, or authority granted by the one House, but at a rate of operations not exceeding the fiscal year 1963 rate or the rate permitted by the one House, whichever is the lower.

In those instances where neither House has passed an appropriation bill for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964, appropriations are provided for continuing projects or activities conducted during fiscal year 1963 at the current rate or the pending budget estimate, whichever is lower, and under the more restrictive authority.

The Committee on Appropriations to whom was referred House Joint Resolution 107, entitled "To provide for the fiscal year 1954 and for other purposes," report the same to the Senate with recommendations and with the opinion that the joint resolution should be passed.

This joint resolution provides for appropriations for the continuing of the operation of the Federal Government for fiscal year 1954, and for other purposes. The joint resolution was passed by the House of Representatives on July 21, 1954.

In this instance, there will be passed both bodies of the Congress and the Senate the same bill. There is no difference of opinion of either body as to the propriety of the bill, and the House of Representatives has passed the bill on July 21, 1954.

Where a bill has passed one House or where an appropriation bill is referred to only one House, the bill shall be passed by both Houses. The bill shall be reported to the Senate by the House of Representatives, and the Senate shall have the right to amend the bill, to pass it, or to reject it. If the Senate rejects the bill, the House may re-pass it, and if the Senate does not act on the bill within the time specified in the Constitution, the bill shall be deemed to have passed.

It is the policy of the House of Representatives to provide for the fiscal year 1954 appropriations as provided for in the bill. The House of Representatives has passed the bill on July 21, 1954, and the Senate has passed the bill on July 21, 1954.
