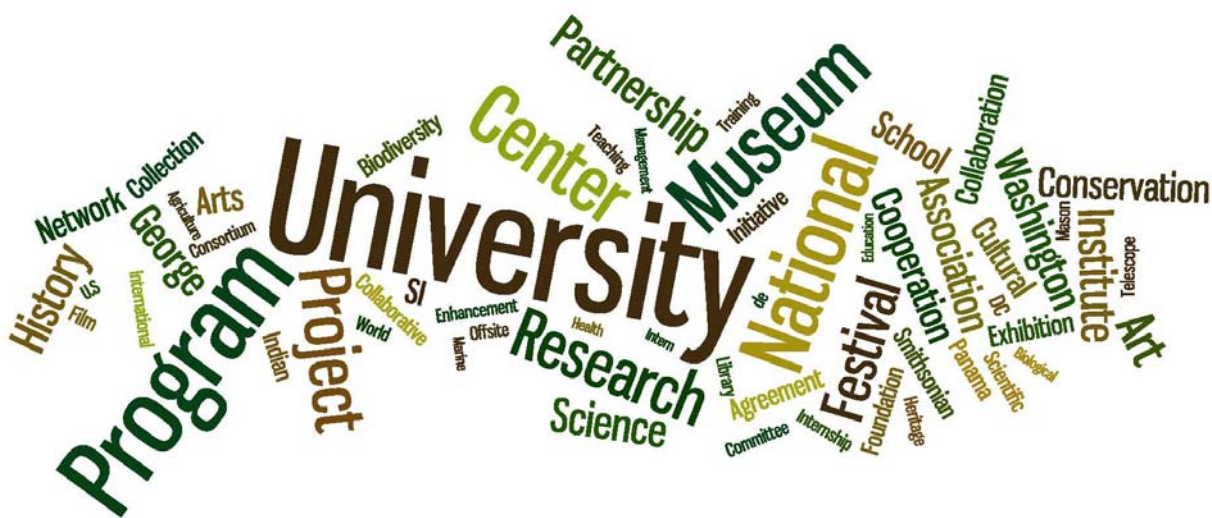

RE: Inventory of Smithsonian Strategic Partnerships with External Organizations

Dear colleagues,

I know we all agree that productive partnerships with other institutions are a key if we are to achieve our aspirations for the future. We have many of long standing and others that are emerging and being planned. In the interest of helping all of us better understand the reach and nature of our partnerships, I have asked Carole Neves and the Office of Policy and Analysis to conduct an online survey of all Smithsonian units to collect baseline information on **active Smithsonian strategic partnerships with external organizations**.

The survey results will be made available to all participating units. I hope that this database will be useful to both central and unit administrations. It will serve to:

- Improve our awareness of existing partnerships and allow units to better coordinate their activities and to enrich connections.
- Help us make our case for funding by illustrating how we are building collaborations as opposed to operating overlapping programs.
- Identify areas where we lack needed partnerships, particularly as we undertake crossdisciplinary initiatives.
- Surface best practices and ways to improve partnership development processes.

The intent of the survey is to collect basic, readily-available information about existing partnerships without requiring inordinate effort by individual respondents – in other words, we are looking for a thumbnail sketch, not accounting records. The questionnaire took approximately 20 minutes to fill out for each partnership in pilot testing.

The Office of Policy and Analysis will work with individual units to facilitate getting the information we seek. The first step, therefore, is for you to **identify a designated contact person for this project**. OP&A staff will work with that person on a distribution plan for the survey within your unit. ## APPENDIX C: PARTNERSHIP SURVEY GUIDANCE

### Guidance on What Partnerships to Include in the Survey

#### *Functions of strategic partnerships in the Smithsonian Strategic Plan*

This survey aims to inventory the current state of active Smithsonian strategic partnerships with external organizations of the type discussed throughout the Smithsonian's Strategic Plan (2010-2015). For example:

*Leverage the Smithsonian's research capacity through partnerships with Federal agencies, universities, nongovernmental organizations, industry, and other private organizations, national and international. (p. 11)*

*Form strategic alliances and partnerships with cultural communities and organizations, domestically and internationally, that advance cultural exchange and the ability of people to preserve, extend, and represent their own cultures. (p. 15)*

*... seek focused, strategic partnerships with diverse organizations to ensure broad-based participation in the research and dissemination of knowledge relating to the American experience. (p. 18)*

#### **Study partnership definition**

For purposes of this study, a partnership is defined as:

A collaborative working relationship between two or more organizations that builds on the time, talent, and resources of participants to achieve common goals, and where partners share decision-making, risks and rewards, participation in activities, and responsibility for outcomes. A partnership may or may not involve a financial transaction and may or may not be based on a formal written agreement.

The definition of "partnership" used in this study has a broader meaning than the legal definition of partnership.

#### **Criteria for inclusion in survey**

To qualify for inclusion in this baseline inventory, the partnership should meet the following three criteria:

- **External** – the partnership involves at least one external (non-Smithsonian) partner, but may also include other Smithsonian unit(s)

- **Organization-level** – the partnership is carried out at the organizational level – at the Institution, unit, center, or department level, but not at the individual level. (For example, we are not looking at partnerships that an SI researcher creates on his/her own with a researcher at another organization to carry out a research project.)
- **Active** – the partnership is currently active. (For example, at the time you are completing this survey, the partnership is engaged in activities; such as project planning or implementation, or negotiation of the terms of a project. That is to say, the partnership is not dormant, although it may still exist on paper.)

***Guidance on what not to include***

To assist units in completing the survey, OP&A has identified relationships that, as a rule, do not meet the definition of “partnership” being used for this study. However, if you believe a relationship in one of the following categories is a partnership in that it involves substantive, mutual benefits and mutual participation in activities, go ahead and include it.

- Acquisition of a service or product
- Loan
- Philanthropy/unrestricted giving
- Sponsorship
- Membership

**Contracts and grants** fall into a gray area. If a contract articulates deliverables that are substantially fixed, and performance is primarily the responsibility of the contractor, it does not meet the definition of “partnership” for purposes of the survey. If the deliverables are variable and require the ongoing input of both parties to be developed, and/or if the contract articulates significant mutual obligations in order to achieve the contract’s goal, then you may want to include it. Similarly, a grant awarded to carry out a particular activity in which the grantor plays no role other than providing funding would not be considered a partnership according to the definition used in the survey. On the other hand, a grant in which the grantor plays a critical role in implementing the specified activities, in collaboration with the grantee, would fit the partnership definition.

***Partnerships versus partners***

This survey deals with “active external partnerships” that may be formed with one or more external organization(s). At the same time, a single external organization may be involved in one or more partnership(s) with the Smithsonian and/or its units. While generally partnerships are associated with a particular program or project, sometimes they are

“umbrella partnerships” that encompass separate projects in which the partners are involved and that may have their own formal or informal agreements.

That is, an “umbrella partnership” as defined here is a formal agreement at the Institution or unit level that was formed to further the partners’ missions and that can involve a range of separate projects or activities at different units, executed separately or collaboratively, and that are not necessarily specifically spelled out within the formal agreement. **For purposes of this survey, please enter the individual partnership projects being carried out under the umbrella partnership.**

For example, the Smithsonian Institution and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to advance intellectual exchange, education and outreach on a range of scientific topics that are consistent with both partners’ missions. This MOU covers multiple projects across the Smithsonian. In 2008, the partnership carried out a workshop on wildlife toxicology and an exhibit on the same topic at the National Zoo, and a project on environmental quality and zoonotic diseases in Panama, among other activities. **You should enter the separate projects in the survey.**

***Date partnership began***

We are looking for the year when the partnership began – that is, when at least two of the partners started working together – regardless of whether the partnership was formal or informal and did or did not involve a formal agreement, and how it may have evolved in the intervening years, including changes in the agreement documents. Thus, for example, if the partnership was formed in 1870, and at least one Smithsonian unit and one of the original external partners are still involved, list that year, regardless of how the partnership has changed up to the present time.

***Partnership ending date***

Answer no if the partnership has no fixed end point, which may include an unspecified number of renewals of the partnership agreement.

## APPENDIX I: EXAMPLES OF PARTNERSHIPS IN HIGH TO MID-RANGE OF MAGNITUDE

### Examples of major unit operating partnerships:

- **Harvard-Smithsonian Center for Astrophysics** – Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory (SAO) and Harvard University  
*To pursue studies of those basic physical processes that determine the nature and evolution of the universe.*
- **US National Academies** – National Science Resources Center (NSRC) and The National Academies  
*To reform K-12 science education in the U.S.*
- **Agreement between the Government of Panama and STRI** – Smithsonian Tropical Research Institute (STRI) and Panama Ministry of Foreign Relations  
*Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Panama and STRI to extend and continue after the termination of the Panama Canal Treaties on December 31, 1999, the mutual scientific cooperation with the benefits and conveniences that will permit STRI the best performance of its scientific and research activities and exercise of its leadership role in tropical biology.*
- **Cooperation with the Systematic Entomology Laboratory, Dept. of Agriculture, Agricultural Research Service** – National Museum of Natural History (NMNH) and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA)  
*The two organizations will continue to work together to build the national treasure embodied in the NMNH Entomological Collections located at the NMNH, Agricultural Research Center (Beltsville) and the Museum Support Center. Both groups of scientists conduct research and provide information and scientific services to a wide array of customers and stakeholders in both the public and private sectors.*
- **NASA Artifacts Transfer Agreement** – National Air and Space Museum (NASM) and National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)  
*The "NASA-NASM Agreement" specifies that NASA will transfer to NASM historic artifacts, after that agency no longer has any programmatic use for them. This includes not only spacecraft but supporting artifacts as well.*

- **NZP-FONZ** – National Zoological Park (NZN) and Friends of the National Zoo (FONZ)

*FONZ helps further the mission of the National Zoo by 1. Educating and inspiring Zoo visitors. It provides the Smithsonian's largest corps of volunteers who serve as Zoo guides, animal care keeper aides, and interpreters; 2. Educating the public, developing curriculum materials for teachers, operating the Zoo-FONZ web presence, and producing Zoogoer magazine; 3. Provides financial support for interns, graduate and postdoctoral research fellows, the acquisition of medicines and food for the Zoo's animal collections, and supports the refurbishment of exhibits and signage; 4. Plans, organizes, and operates camps and classes and major public and member fundraising events; 5. FONZ operates parking, visitor information, and gift concessions and overseeing food operations.*

- **Smithsonian Folklife Festival** – Center for Folklife and Cultural Heritage (CFCH) and National Park Service

*Provide educational and cultural programming in a significant, visible, accessible public space.*

### **Examples of partnerships that are national or international in scope and/or effort:**

- **Global Tiger Initiative** – National Zoological Park (NZN) and World Bank

*Because tiger populations are decreasing at unprecedented rates and urgent action is needed, the bank developed the Global Tiger Initiative and has partnered with NZN/SCBI to provide training to conservation professionals and foster the development and application of interdisciplinary principles of conservation biology.*

- **Haiti Cultural Recovery Project** – Office of the Under Secretary for History, Art and Culture (OUSHAC), Government of Haiti, FOKAL, NEA, NEH, IMLS, U.S. Department of State, Clinton Foundation, President's committee on the Arts and Humanities (PCAH), Blue Shield, UNESCO, American Institute of Conservation, and ICCROM

*To preserve Haiti's cultural heritage after the earthquake.*

- **National Youth Summit – Freedom Rides** – National Museum of American History (NMAH), National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) and WGBH/American Experience

*Produce two programs related to the 1961 Freedom Rides: A National Youth Summit on the Freedom Rides and a screening of the film Freedom Riders. Goal is to reach youth across the nation and engage them in conversation about relevant historical*

*topics, broaden access to the subject, and convene a national dialogue about the Freedom Rides and civic activism.*

- **SHOUT** – Smithsonian Center for Education and Museum Studies (SCEMS), Microsoft Partners in Learning, and Taking it Global

*Inspire student awareness of and engagement in environmental issues.*

- **National Ballast Information Clearinghouse** – SERC and U.S. Coast Guard

*The National Invasive Species Act of 1996 called for the U.S. Coast Guard to establish the Clearinghouse with SERC. The Clearinghouse provides ongoing analysis of status and trends for ship-mediated invasions (and invasion risk) associated with commercial shipping at a nationwide level. In the partnership, SERC conducts research and analysis of ballast water delivery and management, vessel traffic and behavior patterns, and potential consequences for invasions, and provides these analyses for use by USCG and the public.*

- **Archives of American Gardens/Garden Club of American Collection** – OFEO (Smithsonian Gardens) and Garden Club of America

*The Garden Club of America Garden History & Design Committee acts as an informal advisory board for the Archives of American Gardens. They also act as field volunteers who continue to document private gardens across the nation. Smithsonian Gardens staff provide standards for documenting gardens and education on these standards.*

### **Examples of partnerships involving high numbers of external partners:**

- **Thinkfinity** – NMAH, Verizon Foundation, NEH, National Geographic Society, Kennedy Center, National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, National Council of Teachers of English, American Association for the Advancement of Science, International Reading Association, National Center for Family Literacy, and Council for Economic Education

*The grant and partnership support the development of online learning resources for K-12 teachers and students.*

- **Engaging Communities to Foster Internships for Preservation and Curation** – Smithsonian Institution Archives (SIA), University of Michigan, Center for Research Libraries, Florida Center for Library Automation, Stanford University, Northeast Document Conservation Center, Online Computer Library Center (OCLC), Safe Sound Archive, Inter-University Consortium for Social and Political Research, Internet Archive

*Develop educational internships with organizations specializing in digital preservation and curation. Interns for three years paid by grant funds, in exchange for hands-on experience, training, and mentoring of University of Michigan graduate students from the School of Information.*

- **Encyclopedia of Life** – National Museum of Natural History (NMNH) and 23 partners

*To develop a unified system for gaining access to all data related to species and the environment they inhabit. To aggregate, organize, manage and interpret these data. To create a single, comprehensive webpage for each species on earth.*

- **Biodiversity Heritage Library** – Smithsonian Institution Libraries and 17 partners.

*Expand the availability of biodiversity literature via large scale digitization*

- **Astrophysics Data System** – Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory (SAO) and 39 partners

*The ADS is a digital Library portal for researchers in Astronomy and Physics. There are nearly 9 million records. There is a fast search engine, and it is used by the international community.*

- **Museum on Main Street (MoMS)** – Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service (SITES) and 39 partners

*Partner with state humanities councils to expand SI outreach to rural America*

- **Smithsonian and China** – Freer and Sackler Galleries (FSG), 15 SI units, and 22 partners

*Establish a dialogue between American museum professionals and their Chinese counterparts on mutual areas of interest and explore potential collaborative partnerships.*

- **Reciprocal Research Network (RRN)** – National Museum of the American Indian (NMAI) and 11 partners

*Provide digital access to Northwest Coast collections through a web portal housed and maintained by the Laboratory of Anthropology, University of British Columbia.*

### **Examples of major strategic unit partnerships:**

- **SI-Mason Conservation Education Program** – NZP/Smithsonian Center for Conservation Biology (SCBI) and George Mason University

*Partnership with top rated SI scientists and experienced university faculty to create and maintain a program for course credit in conservation biology.*

- **Artful Connections** – Smithsonian American Art Museum (SAAM) and U.S. Department of Defense

*Provide museum resources that support DoD Education Activity (DoDEA) classroom curriculum to teachers and students at DoDEA schools nationally and internationally.*

- **NOAA, Ocean Science and Climate Literacy** – NMNH and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)

*Build upon existing collaboration on ocean science and climate literacy (e.g., Sant Ocean Hall) and develop new areas of collaboration in marine research, marine collections, and ocean science education and outreach. Lifelong ocean education fosters a strong economy, promotes healthy ecosystems and prepares a competitive workforce with the awareness needed to balance the sustainable use and conservation of natural resources.*

- **Environmental Leadership & Training Initiative** – STRI and Yale University, School of Forestry & Environmental Studies

*Develop the Environmental Leadership & Training Initiative, a training program dedicated to enhancing the capacity of policy makers and field practitioners to conserve, restore and reduce major impacts and threat to forests in the Neotropics and tropical Asia.*

- **Mobile Learning Institute** – SCEMS, Pearson, MacArthur Foundation, and Nokia

*Host digital media programs at the Smithsonian: workshops for young people; professional development for educators, and Summits for Educational Leaders. The goal of these offerings is to inform and train these audiences: 1) to use digital media to explore Smithsonian collections and exhibits, and 2) to create products they can*

*share with others. These programs will be evaluated and the results will inform the development of permanent Centers for Innovation at the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden and the National Postal Museum.*

- **U.S. Botanic Garden/Smithsonian Gardens Orchid Exhibits** – OFEO (Smithsonian Gardens) and U.S. Botanic Gardens

*The benefit of this partnership is sharing knowledge and resources. By bringing our two orchid collections together, this yearly orchid exhibit is longer in duration than most exhibitions of orchids in a museum setting.*

- **NISbase** – Smithsonian Environmental Research Center (SERC) and U.S. Geological Survey (USGS)

*Develop and maintain an online data base on the biology and distribution of aquatic invasive species. SERC manages marine and estuarine species, and USGS manages freshwater species. The goal of the partnership is to track and evaluate status and trends for biological invasions in aquatic (freshwater) and marine ecosystems throughout North America. We each maintain the most comprehensive databases for these respective habitats in North America. We use these data for analyses and are creating online 'tools' to access, combine, and display merged data on the fly via dynamic, user-driven queries. Thus, our partnership provides data integration and access at an unprecedented scale for aquatic + marine systems, enabling many applications for research and management.*

*To facilitate collaboration in mutual areas of research and other practice.*

- **International Museum Professional Education (IMPE)** – OUSHAC and Abu Dhabi Authority for Culture and Heritage

*The Smithsonian will offer Museum Professional Training in the Middle East*

- **Collaboration with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency** – NMNH and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

*Enhance working relationships related to research, development, publication, information and knowledge generation and dissemination, and public education and stewardship. NMNH has partnered with EPA on details and projects under the umbrella agreement.*

- **University of Chicago Internship Program** – Office of Fellowships and Interns (OFI) and University of Chicago

*Students benefit by gaining experiences in research and other museum related areas, helping to further their academic and career goals. SI benefits from the outstanding and dedicated students who participate in the program and while learning, assist with the activities of the Institution.*

- **SI Networks** – Smithsonian Enterprises (SE) and Showtime

*Smithsonian Networks was formed to create new television channels that showcase scientific, cultural, and historical programming largely inspired by the assets of the Smithsonian. The Smithsonian envisioned that the channels would be distributed by cable, satellite, and internet broadband service providers and allow the Institution to share its national collections and research with TV viewers.*

- **Giant Magellan Telescope (GMT)** – SAO, Astronomy Australia Ltd., Australian National University, Carnegie Institution for Science, Harvard University, Korea Astronomy and Space Science Institute, Texas A&M University, University of Arizona, University of Chicago, University of Texas at Austin

*To design, construct and operate a 24.5-meter telescope for optical and infrared astronomy.*

- **VERITAS** – SAO and 20 partners

*The Very Energetic Radiation Imaging Telescope Array System (VERITAS) is a ground-based gamma-ray instrument operating at the Fred Lawrence Whipple Observatory (FLWO) in southern Arizona, USA. It is an array of four 12m optical reflectors for gamma-ray astronomy in the GeV - TeV energy range.*

- **Chandra X-ray Center** – SAO, MIT (Massachusetts Institute of Technology), Penn State University, NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration), International Virtual Observatory Alliance

*The goal is to do great science with Chandra. NASA Headquarters is the funding agency. Marshall Space Flight Center is the program management lead. The CXC at SAO reports to Marshall. The CXC is responsible for running peer review for satellite time, mission planning and uploads, in-flight calibration, pipeline processing, data analysis tool development, running workshops for users. MIT and Penn State house instrument teams that contribute to ongoing calibration, maintenance and problem*

*solving. The Chandra Data Archive (part of the CXC) collaborates with the IVOA to ensure that CXC products meet IVOA standards.*

- **Submillimeter Array (SMA)** – SAO, Academia Sinica Institute of Astronomy and Astrophysics (ASIAA), University of Hawaii

*Research using observations from radio interferometer*

- **Multi-Mirror Telescope (MMT) at the Fred Lawrence Whipple Observatory** – SAO and University of Arizona

*Construct and operate the MMT*
