NEW CODE FOR STRI APO ADDRESS

Effective September 6, 1985 the APO Post Office has assigned STRI a four digit add-on. This is to improve timeliness of delivery, especially at the large mail distribution centers which use automated sortation equipment. The Military Postal Service Agency is responsible for implementing "ZIP + 4" for official and regular mail originators at agencies. You should start using the nine digit zip code immediately:
