COCKROACH HUNT

Dallas (AP) -- from darkened closet in the heart of Texas to humid kitchens on the Florida coast, the great cockroach hunt is on as people compete to see who can bag the biggest bug.

Enterprising pest controllers and hardware store owners in several states heve been sponsoring contests, offering cash or merchandise like bug spray for the huskiest insect as a means of bringing in extra customers.

But the promoters say there's more than commercialism at work for the businesses and the entrants.

"They're doing it for the silliness of it -- that's why they bring in a zip-lock bag with a roach in it," said Ronnie Dyer, owner of Drusilla Ace Hardware in Baton Rouge, LA.

"We already know we have foul weather and bad mosquitoes. We claim to have the worst government here in Lousiana. Why shouldn't we have the biggest roach?" he said. "We might as well have some for "

... "When Texas did it first, people said, My God, Florida has bigger roaches than Texas," said John Buthreus, district sales manager of Truly Nolen Pest Control in Clearwater, Fla., which along with WFLA Radio offered \$500 to the winner of an Aug. 15 contest.

"People really got into it," Butherus said. "One lady had a hole connecting a duplex. She kept roaches out of her place. But for the contest, she unplugged the hole and used a funnel to catch the ones from next door as they came over to her half. She brought in about 50 of them."

"I hear they're big (in New York), but I've learned one thing... cockroach hunters are like fisherman: they all lie, and everyone says they're got bigger ones and bigger ones," said. Michael Bohdan, owner of the pest shop and Bizzy Bees Pest Control in Dallas and local contest organizer.
