<u>INSPECTION OF PRIVATELY OWNED</u> <u>VEHICLES WITH MI LICENSE PLATES</u>

STRI staff members are advised that they may use the following companies to take their privately owned vehicles for inspection (revisado):

SUPER MUFFLER, located behind the Corozal PX;

LA CASA DEL DESCUENTO, on Via España, Edificio Domino, next to intersection with Via Argentina; ESTACION SHELL LA CRESTA, on Via España at intersection with Calle Martin Sosa.

If the vehicle requires alignment and adjusting of lights, the cost is usually under \$20.

The following step is to take the vehicle to obtain the inspection sticker at Albrook Field next to the DNTT "Transito" on Gaillard Highway; there is a \$2.10 fee for sticker. Last year's documents are required:

1988 INSPECTION PAPERS (certificado de inspección vehicular);
1988 LICENSE PLATE RECEIPT (recibo de placa);
1988 MI LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION (Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores solicitud de placa).
