OBITUARY

GORDON B. SMALL, an old friend to many at STRI, died on or about 22 January 1989, in San Francisco, California, at the age of 54. A graduate of Brown University, Gordon taught mathematics for 19 years, at Balboa High School and Canal Zone College. His friends knew him Lepidopterist. Most of his free time was learning about Panamanian butterflies, and compiling information to write a field guide to them. During his years here, he amassed a collection (now housed in the NMNH, SI, Washington, DC) of more than 30,000 specimens, the most complete collection of butterflies known for any neotropical continental country. Gordon was a fine pianist and Bach devotee, and it was to the avid analysis of Bach's music that he dedicated the final two years of his life.
