Tuesday, **September 26**, noon seminar speaker will be TOMAS ARIAS, World Health Organization Collaborating Centre, University of Panama.

Population Genetics and Pharmacology of Three Amerindians Tribes of Panama: A Search of Ethnic Identities in Drug Response.

Abstract: The last five years have witnessed a growing recognition that important differences exist among various human races in their response to medicines. These differences are mostly of genetic origin and arise, in turn, from racial specificities in the metabolism of drugs and other xenobiotics, which are likely to result from long-term environmental pressures. Panama is rather unique in that six genetically distinct Amerindian tribes, showing negligible admixture, of known divergence dates and living in diverse ecologies, inhabit a small geographical area. Therefore, their study has allowed us to address issues whose theoretical implications transcend problems relevant only to pharmacology and to the genetics of Amerindians. Results obtained from ten years of studies of four metabolic pathways, in subjects belonging to Kuna, Ngawbe Guaymi and Teribe populations, will be presented.




