

El Día de la Tierra

(tomado del Boletín Recursos)

El 22 de abril de 1990 se iniciará una campaña mundial para atacar los problemas más críticos que amenazan nuestro planeta con el Día de la Tierra 1990.

El director mundial del evento, Denis Hayes, quien fuera director del 1er Día de la Tierra en 1970, afirma que ese día se lanzará a los 90 com la "Década del Ambiente".

Hayes explica en su invitación al mundo para este evento que los problemas de la tierra como la contaminación ambiental, la destrucción de los bosques tropicales, el calentamiento de la Tierra por el efecto de invernadero, la destrucción de la capa de ozono, la proliferación de desechos tóxicos, el avance de la desertificación, la sobre población, los derrames de petróleo, la lluvia ácida y la contaminación de los mares, son amenazas que trascienden las fronteras y por lo tanto deben ser vistos como problemas de todos.

Las decisiones sobre cuál será la forma de participar en este evento serán tomadas a nivel local. Cada país, cada ciudad, cada barrio y cada escuela tendrá sus propios organizadores y su propia agenda. Lo que tendrán en común será el deseo de proteger la tierra de todas estas amenazas y de lograr mejores condiciones de vida.

Algunos temas que se espera poder coordinar a nivel mundial son:

- la plantación de mil millones de árboles;
- la suspensión de sesiones políticas por un día para concentrar a sus líderes en las preocupaciones ambientales de los constituyentes;
- la realización de encuentros urbanos, con desfiles y otras actividades;
- la realización de encuentros educativos en escuelas, colegios y universidades;
- la cobertura masiva del evento en los medios de comunicación;
- la realización de conciertos, eventos culturales y reuniones con celebridades para resaltar los valores ecológicos
- y la realización de eventos religiosos para promover el imperativo moral de restaurar la belleza y sostener toda forma de vida del Planeta.

Computer Tips

from Una Smith

I have a number of nifty software demonstration disks, plus a little shareware which I think may interest STRI personnel, and I would be happy to loan the disks to anyone who asks.

***Mathematics/equation-solving packages***

MATHEMATICA demo: I have 2 versions, one for a Mac, the other for a PC with a VGA graphics card. Mathematica will run on other computers, but the demo needs a VGA. This software has the most polished user interface of all the equation-solving packages on the market today; to get the results to a manuscript, you can save a record of your work session in a text file, and then edit that file later using your favorite word processor.

MATHCAD demo: I have a demo of the PC version. Special features shown in the demo are Fast Fourier Transforms and powerful, intuitive matrix manipulations. It places an emphasis on mixing 'live' equations and manuscript text in the same document, and is an impressive tool for anyone who writes highly mathematical papers. The manuscript can be exported to a word processing package for the final touches.

TRYAPL demo: This is a demo of a true-blue IBM version of APL for the PC. IBM's APL is the Cadillac of APL's, and the demo is also excellent. The demo disk has a 'student' version of the full package, so you can actually use the demo as a tool. All APL's are alike in that they use a special character set instead of long function names, so a small printed manual comes with the demo disk. APL is extremely powerful, fast and general purpose. It is a true programming language, which neither Mathematica nor MathCad are, so if what you want is not built in to either of those, consider exploring TryAPL.

Shareware

PKZIP: This is the most popular file compression/archive utility available, shareware or not. It will compress a typical file to 40% of its original size, and decompress the file back exactly as it was whenever you need it. PKZip will even archive an entire hard disk into a single file, preserving all directory structures and time stamps. If you have trouble with over-stuffed hard disks, or you just want a cheap way to backup data, or to de-fragment your hard disk, PKZip is just the thing to use. The software comes with a detailed instruction manual on the disk.

Columbus Scholars

The United States Columbus' Quincentennial Commission has approved a draft plan for its Columbus Scholars Program which is intended to serve as "a lasting memorial to the spirit of learning and daring with which the name of Columbus is associated." Each year until 1992, 500 highschool juniors, chosen from each of the 435 congressional districts in the United States and from other countries, will be selected to attend the New World Summer Session, a series of seminars at a yet-to-be-chosen university in the United States. Approximately 100 of these students will be awarded full four-year scholarships for undergraduate study at the United States college or university of their choice. "The goal is to create a cadre of talented, accomplished individuals capable of leading the nation in conquering the challenges of the 21st century." 
Abierto de Tenis
