IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT THE NATIONAL CENSUS

Sunday, May 11, 1980 is National Census Day in the Republic of Panama. If you live outside the former Canal Zone area, you and your dependents will not be able to leave your home until a census taker visits your house. If you must report to work that Sunday, a letter to that effect should be requested from your supervisor so that you can report to the appropriate office for a Preliminary Census (from May 7 - 10). If you live in the former Canal Zone area, STRI will report tags your information in writing and identification will be provided in case you wish to leave your house during that day.

ANUNCIO IMPORTANTE SOBRE EL CENSO NACIONAL

El domingo, 11 de mayo de 1980 es el día del Censo Naciunal en la República de Panama. Si Ud. vive fuera de la antigua Zona del Canal, Ud. y sus dependientes no podran salir de su casa hasta que empadronador los visite Si Ud. tiene que trabajar ese domingo, 11 de mayo, solicite una carta de certificación para tal efecto de su supervisor la cual le permitira reportarse para un Censo Preliminar en la oficina del Censo correspondiente a su distrito (del 7 - 10 de mayo). Si Ud. reside en la antigua Zona del Canal STRI reportara por escrito la información correspondiente directamente y se le entregara una contrasena para que se pueda movilizar el día 11.

NEW APPOINTMENT AT STRI

Dr. Gilberto Ocana has recently been appointed to the position of Superintendent of the Barro Colorado Nature Monument at STRI.
Dr. Ocana is the former Dean of the School of Agronomy of the University of Panama.
He received his Ph.D. in plant pathology from the University of California at Riverside.
He is a native of Panama and has had considerable experience in land management. As Superintendent of the Barro Colorado Nature Monument he will be responsible for drawing up a Master Plan for the educational and research utilization of the new areas under STRI custodianship as well as for their protection and preservation.

Dr. Ocana will officially "come on board" on May 19th. We welcome him to STRI and wish him every success in his important new appointment.
