Demography, food availability, and growth of <u>Leptodactylus</u> cf. <u>pentadactylus</u> in the Adolf Ducke Forest Reserve in Central Amazon-Brazil.

Abstract:

In the Adolf Ducke Forest Reserve (Manaus, Brasil), the frog Leptodactylus cf. pentadactylus occupies primary forest and is commonly found along the streams. During 1987 and 1988, 269 individuals were marked and recaptured to provide data on the demography and individual growth. Reproduction was strongly seasonal, limited to less than two months a year (3 years data). The demography of the species was, therefore, characterized by the presence of discrete annual generations and by a sudden increase in population density following the Food consumption rate reproductive season. generally varied in concert with food availability, which was higher in the late dry season and in the rainy season. Size-independent individual's growth rate also varied throughout the year and was significantly related to rainfall, food consumption and food availability.
