*Is the Genus Selaginella (Spike Mosses) Monophyletic?*

### Abstract

The genus *Selaginella* (Selaginellaceae) as traditionally defined contains perhaps over 700 species worldwide, mostly in tropical regions of the world. The taxonomy of the family is still a matter of controversy. Traditionally only a single genus is recognized, however, some taxonomists recognize more than one genus within the family. A reevaluation of the distinguishing characters of the subgenera recognized by Jeremy (1990), as well as a preliminary cladistic analysis, support the reassessment of the Selaginellaceae, and the recognition of at least four genera.


**Self Defense Course ••• Curso de Defensa Personal**

#### **Biology Program**

The Program Ecology of the Rainforest: Tropical Biology and Conservation at the Monteverde Institute, Costa Rica provides students with credit for three courses: Tropical Biology, Spanish language Agroecology, and Independant Study. It will be held from June 18 to August 6, 1992. Sponsored by a consortium of U.S. colleges and universities and administered by the Council on International Education Exchange, the program is designed both to introduce students to the biology of the Neotropics and to Costa Rican culture. The Orientation site will be San José, Costa Rica. 10 semester credit hours are the recommended credits. Eligibility requirements are two semesters of college-level biology, environmental studies, or equivalent and a 2.75 overall GPA. The cost of the course for the Summer of 1992 is \$3,450. Applications: students from sponsoring institutions through home campus. Students from nonsponsoring institutions through Northern Illinois University. Application deadline is March 15. 




