

#### **Stanley Heckadon-Moreno Nuevo Miembro de Junta Directiva de CIFOR**

Stanley Heckadon, sociólogo e investigador asociado del STRI, ha sido escogido recientemente como miembro de la junta directiva del nuevo Centro Internacional para la Investigación Forestal (CIFOR), conocido en inglés como Centre for International Forestry Research. El Dr. Heckadon-Moreno representará a los países de América Latina y el Caribe.

El CIFOR es un centro científico para la investigación forestal con una visión estratégica a nivel mundial, y es la más nueva de las instituciones de investigación científicas del CGIAR (Grupo Consultivo Internacional para la Investigación Agrícola). Este último es una asociación de 40 donantes que apoyan una red de 16 centros internacionales de investigación agrícola con una masa crítica de mil científicos. CIFOR conducirá investigación forestal estratégica dirigida al manejo sostenido de los bosques tropicales de los países en vías de desarrollo. La sede del nuevo organismo científico estará en Asia. El centro operará en estrecha colaboración con las instituciones de investigación existentes en Asia, África y América Latina.

#### **Guidelines for the Use of the Tupper Conference Center and Meeting Rooms**


