The handwriting of Grandma Moses reflects the mood and pace of her days, as well as the nature of the task at hand. Ranging from fancy to plain, Moses's

execution mirrors the twin roles she played: the artist and the farmwife.

The solitary Christmas card signature is evidence that Moses could turn out a cultivated script when she took the time. The writing style in her letters to friends and family, however, defaults quickly from elegant flourishes into a pleasant and practical — grandmotherly — forward-leaning script. Legibility falls increasingly by the wayside as Moses attempts to negotiate a demanding schedule, a high volume of family news, and a limited amount of space on which to write. For Moses, writing may have been very similar to both needlework and painting: an everyday act for lovingly recording, sharing, and remembering the riches of family life.
