

## 19. BIBLIOGRAPHY OF DIEGO GARCIA

Items in this bibliography containing specific references to Diego Garcia are marked with a single asterisk\*. Items containing references to other Chagos islands or to the Chagos archipelago generally, without specific mention of Diego Garcia, are marked with a double asterisk\*\*. The Bibliography also contains a number of items to which reference has been made in the text but which do not deal either with the Chagos islands or with Diego Garcia, and these are left unasterisked. The main bibliographic sources on the Chagos Archipelago are as follows: general, historical, public records, maps - Toussaint and Alphonse (1956); historical - Scott (1961); climate - Wallace (1963); geography and ecology - Sachet and Fosberg (1955). There is also much of relevance in my own bibliographies of the Maldives Islands (Stoddart, ed., 1966) and of Aldabra (Stoddart 1967). This bibliography is probably reasonably complete for items of geographical and ecological nature; only select historical items are included, however, and no attempt has been made to scan published official and unpublished archival records, a guide to which is included in the bibliography by Toussaint and Alphonse (1956).

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
