Among those added of interest to STRI are the <u>Electronic</u> <u>Yellow Pages</u>, which include listings for Services, Manufacturers, Professionals, Retailers, and Wholesalers in the U.S.; <u>International</u> <u>Software</u> <u>DataBase</u>--information on more than 10,000 computer programs, and Zoological Record.
