STRI is responsible to return the "special residency permit" to the Ministry of Government and Justice, if for any reason the bearer of the permit terminates his/her association with STRI. If this were the case, please return the "special residency permit" to Mrs. Adela Gomez or Mrs. Elena Lombardo.
