Recruitment and the Dynamics of Rocky Shore Populations along the Pacific Coast of Central America.

ABSTRACT: Populations of barnacles Tetraclita panamensis and Chthamalus fissus along the Pacific coast of Costa Rica were censused photographically from March 1983 to November 1985. Population dynamics and individual interactions were largely determined by patterns of recruitment. Recruitment rates and abundance of sessile animals are much lower in the Bay of Panama; this may be due to offshore larval transport by seasonal upwelling. Most present models of the structure and dynamics of benthic assemblages do not apply to communities regulated by recruitment.
