- Have many interests. If you can't travel, read about new places.
- Don't hold postmortems. Don't spend your life brooding over sorrows and mistakes. Don't be one who never gets over things.
- Do what you can for those less fortunate than yourself.
- Keep busy at something. A busy person never has time to be unhappy.
