Theoretical Epidemiology and Conservation

Abstract

Both epidemiology and conservation biology are concerned with the eradication of species, with different goals in mind, of course. Whereas conservation biology is a new discipline, epidemiology is a mature one. The possibility is explored of mining the simple theoretical framework developed in epidemiology for insights which may be of use to conservation biology. In particular, epidemiology, provides a simple estimate of the eradication threshold of a population, i.e. the minimum amount of a population's limiting resource required for that population to persist. Metapopulation theory also straddles both disciplines, and simple metapopulation models are discussed with respect to their implications for the consequences of habitat change on community structure.


