

The Use of Microsatellite analysis in Mammalian Behavioral Studies

Abstract

Microsatellites are short sequence repeats that are randomly distributed in the genome. Highly polymorphic microsatellites are common in most mammals. We use microsatellite analysis to determine parentage, calculate the level of relatedness within and between various social groupings and hierarchies, estimate the extent of extra-pair copulation, and calculate reproductive success. In this talk, I will review our statistical methodology, and provide some empirical examples from our recent studies.
