##### Reminder from the Director

May 1 is the deadline for the Collection-based Research Program Grant for supporting staff research based on SI collections in the arts and humanities. The maximum is \$10,000, 1-year grants.

##### Jacana's New Schedule ••• *Nuevo Horario de "Jacana"*

The "Jacana's" schedule changed on week-days on April 1. It leaves Gamboa at 7:15am to arrive at BCI at 7:45am. In the afternoon leaves BCI at 3:40pm, to arrive in Gamboa at 4:20pm. These changes were required to integrate the BCI ferry service with the SACA bus service to Gamboa. The changes represent a net loss of 5 min per day on the island, but are important to allow employees the use of public transportation. ##### From BCI ••• *De Barro Colorado*

When visiting BCI, please be aware that, since space in the "Jacana" is running almost at full capacity, reservations are necessary. Since the navigation laws of the Panama Canal do not allow overload in ships, you may be left in Gamboa or BCI. Allow yourself extra time to arrive at the dock. All passengers must be on board 5 minutes before departure, both from Gamboa to BCI and back. Do not wait for the horn at BCI. Launch operators are not responsible to wait for late passengers. If you miss the boat at BCI, you will be charged for the night at BCI or the special boat (if available). All these measures are important for the normal flowing of people from and to BCI.
