

Intraspecific Acoustic Communication in Moths

Abstract

Research on moth sound reception and emission has concentrated on predator-prey (usually bat-moth) interactions since the work of Roeder and Treat in the '60's. But as early as 1864 and 1912 researchers were aware of sound being produced by arctiid moths during courtship. Adequate ultrasonic equipment by 1984 enabled Spangler to record the signals of pyralid moths during mating. Here I deal with two, brightly colored, wasp-like moths (Ctenuchinae) and the sounds produced during courtship and other behavioral interactions. Location of the emitting and receiving organs will be discussed as well as the abdominal tympanic organs of moths.

Charlas Smithsonian del Mes

On Thu, Sep 26, there were no seats left at the Salón Las Oropéndolas, Metropolitan Park, due to the overflow crowd of interested people attending the fifth "Charla Smithsonian del Mes". This monthly series of talks in Spanish for the lay public, is sponsored by STRI and the Patronato of

the Metropolitan Park, commemorating the 150th Anniversary of the Smithsonian Institution. Last Thu, Wibke Thies, from the University of Tubingen, lectured on the secret life of bats (*La Vida Secreta de los Murciélagos*). Local TV 2 channel covered the event, was also attended by the German Ambassador and his wife. With an overhead projector, slides and taped sounds of bats, the life of one of the most maligned and misunderstood creatures of the tropical forest was revealed to the audience, as well as how to study them. Prejudices and misconceptions about bats were shed by a thrilled audience that kept asking more questions at the end of the talk. At this "charla" there was a great attendance by children with their parents, who asked "how can you tell if a bat is a boy or a girl", while a parent, a hotel owner asked how he could drive away the bats from his hotel without harming them.

Learn to Speak Spanish


